


## PREFACE

*Nosferatu*, the 1922 cult classic and prototype of the vampire movie, celebrated its centennial in 2022 with international media coverage. Berlin hosted a major [exhibition](#) titled "Phantoms of the Night: 100 Years of Nosferatu," a British [anniversary trailer](#) summed up the film's enduring popularity, and the New York Times [remembered](#) "The Vampire Movie that Won't Die." *Nosferatu*, which alludes to the mass deaths of World War I and the 1918 Spanish flu pandemic, also resonated with the recent Covid-19 pandemic that killed seven million people worldwide. There is great anticipation for Robert Eggers' long-awaited [remake](#) of "*Nosferatu*," scheduled for release in 2025.
